Handbook Addendum

Chapter 1 - Introductory Information and General Notices

- Facial coverings must be worn by K-12th grade students while in hallways or common areas.
- Facial coverings must be worn by 2nd – 12th grade students while in classrooms.
- K-1st grade students may be allowed to remove facial coverings while seated in the classroom.
- No visitors are allowed in the building (unless there's an emergency)

Chapter 2 - Attendance

- Daily attendance is mandatory for face-to-face learning and online learning.
- Parents/Guardians must notify the office if your child will be absent for any reason, and report illness/symptoms.
- Truancy referrals will be made if there is no evidence of regular daily attendance.

Chapter 3 - Progress Reports, Promotion and Graduation

- All students at risk of failure will receive a progress report.
- High school graduation requirements remain unchanged for face-to-face and online learners.

Chapter 4 - Student Fees and Meal Costs

- Universal Breakfast will be provided to all students at no cost
- Meals will be available for online students if requested (pick up only - curbside)

Chapter 5 - Transportation and Parking

- All students will be required to wear facial coverings on the bus at all times.
- Students will not be allowed to board the bus without facial coverings.
- Students will be required to sanitize while entering and exiting the bus.
- For safety purposes, all students will have an assigned seat on the bus.

- Temporary rerouting: Parents will be asked to drop off students off in the circle drive curbside. Parents will be asked to remain in the car for safety and to keep the flow of the traffic.

Chapter 6 - Health and Safety

- All safety protocols and procedures (detailed in the roadmap) will be observed.
- Desks will be distanced and students should maintain distancing and classroom setup.
- Students will be screened for symptoms daily, including temperature checks prior to entering the building. Parents should monitor their child's general health and well-being and use discretion when determining daily attendance.
- Students will be required to perform regular hand-washing and sanitizing.
- The district will fully cooperate with the [local health department](#) about possible and confirmed COVID-19 cases.
- If a student presents symptoms related to COVID-19 while at school, parents will be contacted and the student must be picked up within 1 hour.
- If the student is quarantined or has a suspected COVID-19 case, parents must present negative COVID-19 test results or be symptom free before reentering school. If necessary local health department contacts will be consulted.

Chapter 7 - Discipline and Conduct

- Students are encouraged to arrive between 7:45 A.M. and 8:05 A.M.
- Students will have a designated space during common times (before school and during lunch).
- School dress code applies when attending virtual meetings.
- All students will be required to follow all COVID-19 rules and regulations or be subjected to discipline according to the handbook.
- Students must report to the designated area for lunch
 - Elementary - outside tent only (before inclement weather)
 - MS & HS - outside, cafeteria, annex, art room or library
- Due to increased safety precautions, students will not be allowed to use the microwave during lunch. Microwave will not be available.
- No field trips will be scheduled at this time.

Chapter 8 - Internet, Technology and Publications

- All technology rules listed in the school handbook apply.
- Students will be required to take care of school-issued devices and contact the school if issues arise.
- Families will be responsible for lost or damaged school-issued devices.

Chapter 10 - Athletics

- All parents and student athletes must sign the Assumption of Risk/Waiver of Liability/Indemnification Agreement to participate in athletic activities.
- All COVID-19 related MHSAA decisions will be followed.
- Eligibility rules and guidelines will apply to all face-to-face and online learners.

- Attendance requirements will apply to face-to-face and online learners.
